Prothrapur (Andamans)

The 15th of August each year is an important and special occasion for the diocese of Port Blair as on this beautiful day the feast of Our Lady of Velankani is celebrated with pomp and enthusiasm. As a spiritual preparation different parishes observed the Novena to our Lady of Velankani, consequently Prothrapur parish too started to have the Novena on 6th August 2019 onwards. In order to run this program various villages, Associations and communities were given responsibilities, consisted of leading the liturgy, readings, choir, prayer of the faithful etc.

As well informed in advance, the parishioners of St. Joseph's Catholic Church Prothrapur undertook padyatra (pilgrimage) from Bambooflat to Panighat Shrine on 8th August, 2019. The day was pleasant one. All were in a prayerful mood, consisted of about 200 people most of them ladies, assembled at Bambooflat Jetty by 1.30 in the afternoon and proceeded to Panighat Shrine with chanting and prayers, slogans and hymns. The Panighat Shrine is famous for the Mother Mary of Velankani, our Lady of Health. After reaching the grotto at the original Shrine, the devotees lighted candles and offered to Mother Mary, spent little time in personal prayer and later the faithful entered into the Shrine situated on the hillock at Panighat. Immediately after entering into the Church, the devotees started Novena in honour of our Mother Mary. Fr. Edward Kerketta, S. J. was the main celebrant for the Eucharist, whereas Frs. Mahipal and Charles were concelebrants.

In fact on 14th August, it has been the tradition of the diocese to go for a pilgrimage to Panighat shrine

walking through Port Blair, Bathubasti, Chouldhari, Mithakhari, Bambooflat and Hope Town. They begin their journey from Stella Maris Cathedral, Port Blair at 7.00 A.M. and reach Panighat Shrine around 3.00 P.M. Not only the Christians but also people of other faith join the padyatra and make themselves feel united in Andamans, the "Mini India". The day is concluded with the celebration of the Eucharist.

Prison Ministry Sunday was celebrated at Prothrapur parish on 11th August. Fr. Edward, the assistant parish priest was the main celebrant. Based on the pastoral letter, Bishop Alwyn D'silva highlighted some of the important points related to this Ministry and requested for their kind cooperation and contribution to support our brothers and sisters behind bars.

The month of August was a joyful month. On 3rd of August five members of the community attended an ordination of a Jesuit priest Fr. Jean Baptist Musiitwa S.J. in Masaka district of Uganda. The reception party on the ordination day was arranged in a hotel. The wife of the Vice president of Uganda was one of the distinguished guests. Following day, the newly ordained priest celebrated his first thanksgiving Mass in his village. The celebration in the village was quite similar to that of ours. We came back to our community on 5th of August. Fr. Afulo S.J., the East African Provincial followed us the next day for his visitation to our community and the school.

The school was busy with the End of Term examination from 6th to 14th of August. Students had to write 2-3 exams every day. The inauguration of a newly constructed basketball court was done by the donors from USA. There was friendly match to mark the event. On 15th we celebrated the feast of the Assumption of Mary. Fr. Joe Rodriguez was the main celebrant of the Holy Mass. On 17th of August some of the staff members went for an outing to Murchison Falls which is inside the National Park of Uganda. Three of us who didn't belong to East African Community had to pay more fees to enter into the park. We saw wild animals: Elephants, Lions, dears, boars, giraffes etc. It was an amazing experience.

The Students went on holidays with their exam results on the 23rd of August for three weeks. Their common means of transport for short distance was Boda-Boda (motor cycle). On the same evening all the teaching and non-teaching staff members had a party with lots of fun and dancing in one of the restaurant in Gulu town. Mr. Augustine, a French volunteer went back to France on the same night.

During the holidays some of us did manual work in the garden and in the field. Since the campus is big, the students from nearby villages were asked to slash grass and clear the surroundings.
